With the stamp of Lili & Andor Foldes as well as Andor Foldes’s bookplate on the front paste-down. Andor Foldes was one of the greatest pianists of the 20th century. J.B. Priestley, at the time a much bigger fish than Greene, alleged that one of the characters, a writer called Q. C. Savory, was a defamatory representation of himself. On pages 77, 78, 82, 98, and 131 the name was changed to Quin Savory and for some reason "Dickens" was changed to "Chaucer". This occurs at line 2, page 82 and is a quick way of determining precedence. Very few copies survive in the uncorrected state. Comes with a fine \$22+ facsimile dustwrapper. CHF 200

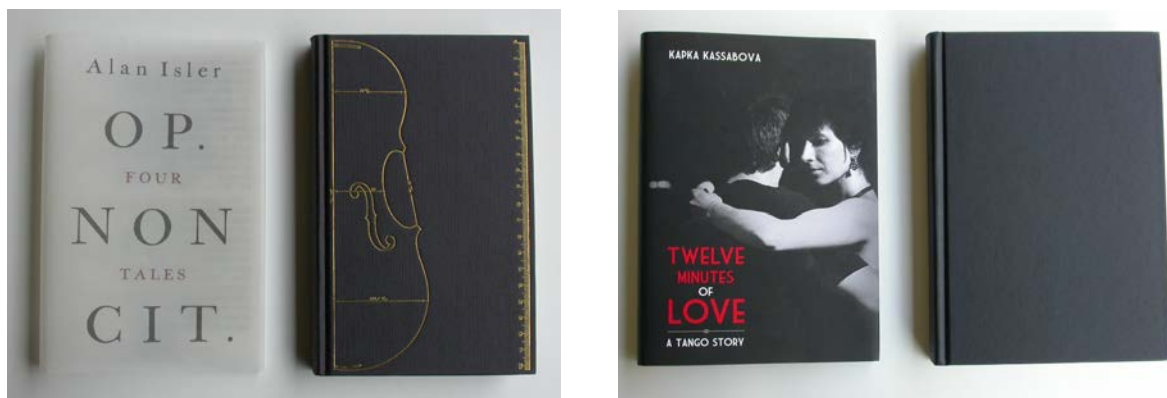
