

These works are not framed. They come with a vignette and a label (the latter can be cut to look like a bookmark), both of which are printed on one side of a folded custom-made sheet:

Both the vignette and label of each work are signed and dated by the artist.

The canvasses can be hung on either side, as verso and recto of each canvass differ substantially. The photographs below show both sides.

The sizes given are an approximation due to the irregular shapes of the canvasses.

To facilitate hanging or framing you can steam iron the canvasses at low temperatures.

Price for each work is CHF 500.


